## NOTIFICATION OF EXEMPTION

Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994 Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004

> Maritime Safety Agency of Queensland Brisbane, 25 January 2005

I, Captain Arthur-James Forsyth Diack, Acting General Manager, Maritime Safety Queensland, pursuant to section 18A of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act* 1994, exempt the ship detailed in the following schedule, operated by P&O Australian Resorts Pty Ltd, from complying with the provisions of Part 4, Division 2, Subdivision 3, section 88 (2) of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation* 2004 relating to the minimum licence required to operate the ship, subject to the following conditions.

### CONDITIONS

- The ship must:
  - a. Operate in daylight hours and favourable weather conditions only; and
  - b. Operate in sight of and within 0.5 nautical miles of the Heron Island Resort; and
  - c. Be in constant radio contact with Heron Island Resort.
- 2. Before a person holding a Coxswain certificate operates the ship, that person must have performed a minimum of ten (10) supervised trips and subsequently be signed off by P&O Australian Resorts Pty Ltd management as being competent for this operation; and
- 3. This exemption only applies while the ship is operated by P&O Australian Resorts Pty Ltd out of Heron Island Resort.
