I refer to your letter of the 31 st July, and my discussions with your Mr Kilmister on the 17 th August and advise as follows:-

1. Whilst recognising the wide powers the Commissioner has under the Main Roads Acts as far as entry is concerned on freehold lands, it is submitted that it is the intent of the act that the Commissioner should use these powers in a responsible and sensible way. The area shown by you as an area of interest was used by your Department as a borrow pit some years ago and was left in a terrible mess. I personally had to hire a dozer and tidy up the borrow area. I am not prepared to let your Department do this again.

2. The area shown, in my opinion, does not have much suitable

material left anyway.

3. The Act does not allow the Commissioner to unilaterally define the level of compensation, and you are advised that the terms of compensation offered are completely unacceptable.

4. If you require fill, there are other areas where I would be prepared to let you borrow from, but the terms and conditions



16. The Commissioner may, in or through or along any private lands or roads, make and open such ditches, gutters, tunnels, drains or watercourses as the Commissioner thinks advisable for the purpose of draining, making, or improving any declared road.

The Commissioner may, for the purpose of draining, making, or improving any declared road, cause the drainage from such road to be diverted into any ditch, guiter, tunnel, drain, or watercourse on any road or private land.

The Commissioner may scour, cleanse, and keep open all such ditches, gutters, tunnels, drains or watercourses.

- 25. (1) For the purposes of this Act, the Commissioner or any person authorised either specially or generally by him may—
 - (a) Enter and re-enter from time to time upon any land, with such assistants as are required, to make any survey which is authorised to be made;
 - (b) Affix or set up thereon trigonometrical stations, survey pegs, marks, or poles, and from time to time after, remove, inspect, reinstate, and repair the same;
 - (c) Dig and bore into the land so as to ascertain the nature of the soil, and set out the lines of any works thereon;
 - (d) Do all things necessary for the purposes aforesaid.
- (2) When practicable, reasonable notice shall be given to the owner or occupier of the land of the intention to enter thereon, and the authority under which the person entering claims to enter or has entered shall, if required by such owner or occupier, be produced and shown.
 - (3) Every person who-
 - (a) Without due authority destroys, mutilates, defaces, takes away, or alters the position of any trigonometrical station, survey peg, mark, or pole fixed or set up by any person under the authority of this section; or
- (b) Wilfully obstructs any person acting under the authority of this section; shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars.
- 26. (1) The Commissioner may temporarily occupy and use any land for the purpose of constructing or repairing any works, and may:—
 - (a) Take therefrom stone, gravel, earth, and other material;
 - (b) Deposit thereon any material;
 - (c) Form and use temporary roads thereon;
 - (d) Manufacture pipes or other materials thereon;
 - (e) Erect machinery, workshops, sheds, and other buildings of a temporary nature thereon.

NOTE-

The owner of the land is advised that at any time during occupation by the Commissioner or his agents, he may give notice to the Commissioner that he intends claiming compensation under the provisions of the *Main Roads* Act 1920–1983 for any damage done during such occupation.

16. The Commissioner may, in or through or along any private lands or roads, make and open such ditches, gutters, tunnels, drains or watercourses as the Commissioner thinks advisable for the purpose of draining, making, or improving any declared road.

The Commissioner may, for the purpose of draining, making, or improving any declared road, cause the drainage from such road to be diverted into any ditch, gutter, tunnel, drain, or waterourse on any road or private land.

The Commissioner may scour, cleanse, and keep open all such ditches, gutters, tunnels, drains or watercourses.

- 25. (1) For the purposes of this Act, the Commissioner or any person authorised either specially or generally by him may—
 - (a) Enter and re-enter from time to time upon any land, with such assistants as are required, to make any survey which is authorised to be made;
 - (b) Affix or set up thereon trigonometrical stations, survey pegs, marks or poles, and from time to time alter, remove, inspect, reinstate, and repair the same;
 - (c) Dig and bore into the land so as to ascertain the nature of the soil, and set out the lines of any works thereon;
 - (d) Do all things necessary for the purposes aforesaid.
- (2) When practicable, reasonable notice shall be given to the owner or occupier of the land of the intention to enter thereon, and the authority under which the person entering claims to enter or has entered shall, if required by such owner or occupier, be produced and shown.
 - (3) Every person who-
 - (a) Without due authority destroys, mutilates, defaces, takes away, or alters the position of any trigonometrical station, survey peg, mark, or pole fixed or set up by any person under the authority of this section; or
- (b) Wilfully obstructs any person acting under the authority of this section; shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding one hundred access.
- 26. (1) The Commissioner may temporarily occupy and use any land for the purpose of constructing or repairing any works, and may:—
 - (a) Take therefrom stone, gravel, earth, and other material;
 - (b) Deposit thereon any material;
 - (c) Form and use temporary roads thereon;
 - (d) Manufacture pipes or other materials thereon;
 - (e) Erect machinery, workshops, sheds, and other buildings of a temporary nature thereon.

NOTE-

The owner of the land is advised that at any time during occupation by the Commissioner or his agents, he may give notice to the Commissioner that he intends claiming compensation under the provisions of the Main Roads Act 1920–1983 for any damage done during such occupation.



2. 'As Constructed' Plans

The 'As Constructed' plans were tabled and each variation discussed. The amendments shown on the drawings were considered to be a proper representation of the 12E's on the job.

Section 2.1 of the minutes contains feedback to the designers and Section 2.2 briefly details other variations made on site which were of a local nature and could not be attributed to any omissions in the design phase.

2.1 Feedback to the Designers

(a) Type Cross-Sections

Type cross-sections used to highlight short sections of different treatment through the job should be an accurate representation of that section. If the section is super-elevated throughout it should be shown as such and not shown as normal 3% crossfall. (Refer Plan 216648).

(b) Kerb and Channel

Kerb and channel cross-sections should be of such a dimension and configuration that they are compatible with locally available moulds. (Refer Plan 216648).

(c) Subscil Drains

Where possible, subsoil drains should outlet into the wingwalls of proximate culvert structures, rather than have their own individual outlet treatment. In many cases this will not be possible however where possible from a maintenance perspective it is desirable. Incorporating the outlet in the wingwall requires less effort on the constructors behalf and is far superior for recording and future maintenance.

(d) Grade-Line

Wherever possible consider the lowering of grades through cuttings or the widening of cuttings to allow for spoil on the job. Where there is no other conflict or reason for not doing so the lowering of the grade-line should be considered as obtaining suitable fill material from private property is becoming more and more difficult.

(e) Accesses General

Careful consideration must be given to accesses and the need for under drainage. Accesses should scheduled separately and not allowed for under the Provision For Traffic item where there is any alteration to alignment or grade of the existing road.

(f) Linemarking

Linemarking at the job extremities needs to be compatible with adjacent sections and adjacent features eg crests.

(g) Business Accesses

Careful consideration must be given to the treatment at accesses to business where there is a high fill situation and the accesses are located on the lower side of super elevated multi-lane situations. Cite the situation at the accesses to the Rollingstone Hotel and service station. Grate drains need to be provided at the toe of the access to capture road surface water runoff. Also the location needs to be carefully considered in relation to potential conflicts with appurtenances. The type of access and its geometry needs to be carefully considered in these high fill situations.

(h) Concrete Backfill to Kerbs

The use of concrete backfill to semi-mountable kerbs in lieu of selected backfill is desirable. It gives far greater rigidity and strength to the kerb which can be easily damaged by traffic otherwise. The kerb and backing is mechanically extruded and the cross-section to be adopted must be compatible with locally available moulds.

3. <u>Documentation Improvements</u>

It is proposed in future jobs that a detailed drawing be prepared for skew culverts giving setting out dimensions etc due to the error in interpreting the Std Dwg 1177 for Culvert 3L.

4. Lessons Learnt

- The problems of the fatty sections on the job was discussed. It was agreed that these sections corresponded to those that had a primerseal. Agreed that the spray rates weren't the problems, rather there could be a problem with the cut-back bitumen (suggest cutting on site).
- Be wary of selecting extraordinarily low quotes on major items of work for bids. Cite the problems with the Readymix supply of gravel to Rollingstone and the extra cost it has incurred. This matter is continuing to be dealt with by the Crown Solicitor.
- Ensure that the authority for any established road reserve is the Departments before clearing for borrow areas. Occasionally local authorities have future road requirements from wide road reserves.

5. Test Results

- Quality Assurance was trialled on this job however due to insufficient staffing and staff changes the system became too difficult to administer.

Following the service upon you of a Notice of Intention to Resume dated the 7th day of January 88, relating to land as described therein, your attention is now drawn to a Proclamation published in the Gazette of the 14th day of May 88, declaring that the land described in the said Proclamation is taken by the Commissioner of Main Roads, as from the date of publication.

I herewith serve upon you the attached copy of the said Proclamation.

From and after the date of publication of the Proclamation in the Gazette, the land taken vests as prescribed in the Proclamation and, from that date, your estate or interest therein is converted into a right to claim compensation.

The statutory provisions regarding the making and lodging of a claim for compensation are set out in Section 19 of the Act and the principles upon which compensation is assessed in Section 20. These sections are quoted on the attachment hereto.

The amount of compensation to be paid may be agreed upon between yourself and The Commissioner of Main Roads but, should you so desire, if the amount of compensation has not been sooner agreed upon, you may, at any time after service of your claim on The Commissioner of Main Roads refer the matter for determination by the Land Court and/or apply for an advance against compensation to be agreed upon or determined pursuant to Section 23 of the Act.

Attached is a pro forma claim form which may be adapted to your particular requirements together with a Statutory Declaration for completion by an owner claimant as required by Section 19(1)(c) of the Act.

The Act imposes no time limit for the making of a claim. However it is desirable that the person entitled to claim will do so at the earliest possible date.

SECTIONS 19 AND 20 - THE ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT

- Claim for compensation. (1) A claim for compensation shall be in writing, shall be served upon the constructing authority, shall state in full the name and address of the claimant, shall be signed by the claimant, and shall contain or be accompanied by -
 - (a) a description of the land taken and a statement of the area thereof;
 - (b) a statement of the nature and particulars of the claimant's estate or interest in the land taken;
 - (c) a statement (which, in the case of the owner, shall be verified by statutory declaration) as to whether or not the claimant's estate or interest in the land taken is subject to any trust, obligation, mortgage, lease, agreement to lease, charge, rate, contract, claim or other estate or interest whatsoever and, if so, the nature and particulars of those of the aforesaid to which the estate or interest is subject.
 - (d) an itemised statement of the claim, showing the nature and particulars of each item and the amount claimed in respect thereof;
 - (e) the total amount of compensation claimed.
- (2) Where the estate or interest of the claimant is not registered or notified in the office of the Registrar of Titles, the claim shall be accompanied by proof of Title to the estate or interest claimed, which proof shall include copies of or abstracts from all documents, if any, necessary to establish in law the estate or interest.
- 20. Assessment of compensation. (1) In assessing the compensation to be paid, regard shall in every case be had not only to the value of land but also to the damage, if any, caused by either or both of the following namely -
 - (a) the severing of the land taken from other land of the claimant;
 - (b) the exercise of any statutory powers by the constructing authority otherwise injuriously affecting such other land.
- (2) Compensation shall be assessed according to the value of the estate or interest of the claimant in the land taken on the date when it was taken.
- (3) In assessing the compensation to be paid, there shall be taken into consideration, by way of set-off or abatement, any enhancement of the value of the interest of the claimant in any land adjoining the land taken or severed therefrom by the carrying out of the works or purpose for which the land is taken.

But in no case shall this subsection operate so as to require any payment to be made by the claimant in consideration of such enhancement of value.

23. Advance against compensation. A claimant for compensation as the owner of the land taken may at any time after the date on which he delivered to the constructing authority his claim for compensation in accordance with the requirements of section nineteen of this Act, apply to the constructing authority to make him an advance.






