



Boundary Road (Coopers Plains) rail level crossing project

Project update

The Boundary Road rail level crossing project aims to reduce congestion and improve safety. Following community consultation on two design options, the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) worked closely with Brisbane City Council and Queensland Rail to develop a business case in 2022 for the preferred option.

The project footprint has been finalised following the completion of site investigation works undertaken in late 2023 with design completed in September 2024.

Funding

This \$399 million project is jointly funded by the Australian Government, Queensland Government and the Brisbane City Council.

Australian Government – \$179.5 million
Queensland Government – \$179.5 million
Brisbane City Council – \$40 million.



Project features

The new Boundary Road rail crossing will include:

- an overpass over the existing rail line at Boundary Road and elevated three-way intersection connecting Boundary Road and Orange Grove Road to improve safety and reduce congestion
- new active transport facilities, including on and off-road bike riding connections and dedicated and accessible pedestrian paths to improve connectivity for pedestrians and people riding their bikes
- improved local access, including new traffic connections.

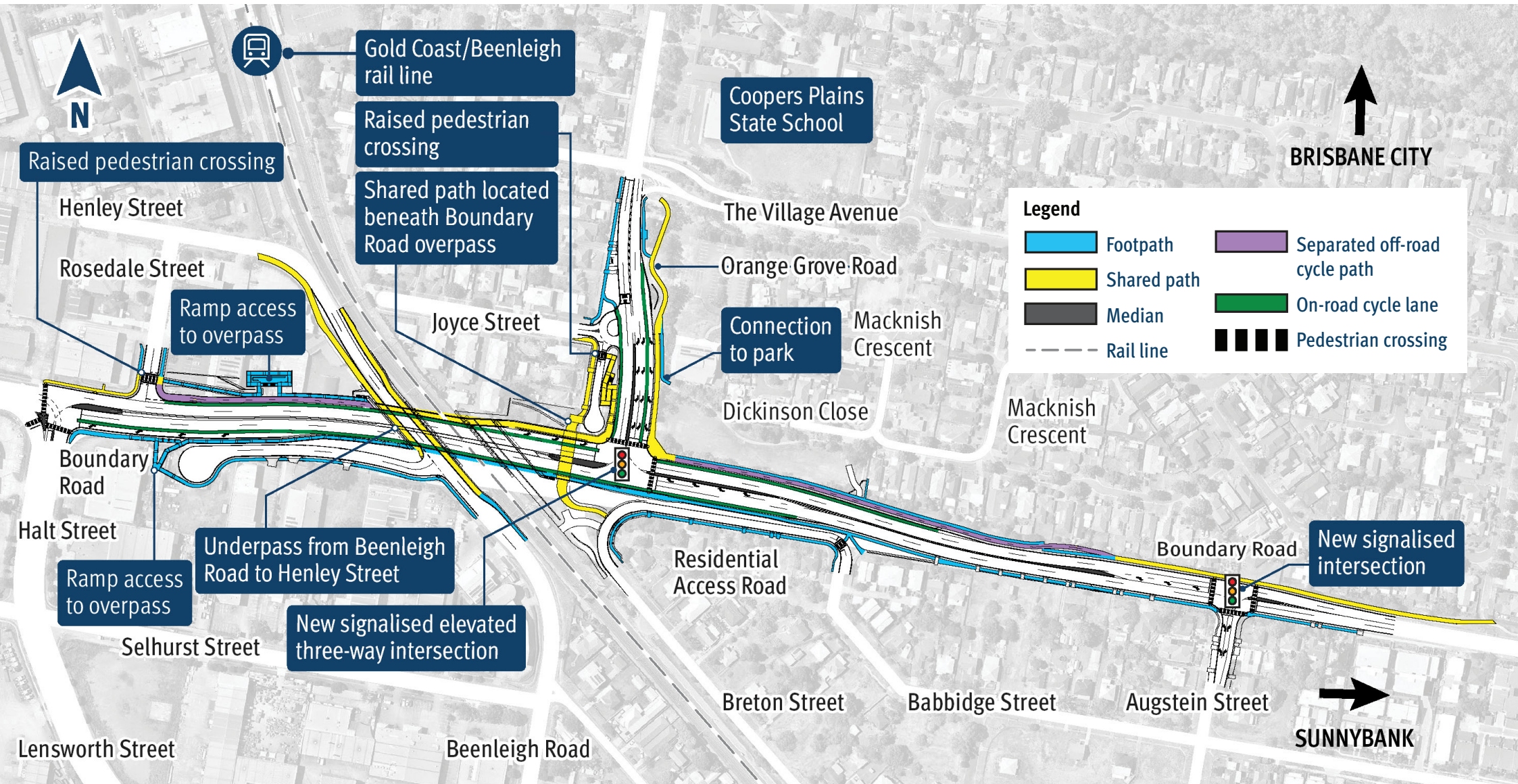
