Ollera Creek Bridge open to all traffic

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is pleased to announce the Ollera Creek Bridge has opened to all traffic.

Teams on the ground have worked around the clock in inclement weather over several days to fast-track the repairs, and we celebrate and thank them for their hard work in managing to re-open the bridge and restore this vital connection for the community.

The bridge, which serves as a key link for vehicles travelling between Townsville and Cairns, will now be accessible to the general public, after opening to freight, supply and emergency vehicles at 8pm last night (10 February).

Please drive carefully and follow all signs and directions.

The road crossing at Seymour River is flooded with modelling indicating that this will remain closed until as late as Thursday evening.

Further updates and advice on travel and road conditions will continue to be communicated by the relevant authorities. TMR remains committed to your safety and ensuring the reliability of our road network.
