- Privately owned freehold and interests (easements, leases, licences, etc) in freehold and state lands can be resumed.
- Other government owned land must be acquired by agreements, consents and or legislated processes.
- Timings are typical approximates. AMT actions timing can be more or less (depending on number of properties, owners and interests, and concurrent projects, etc). Min, DPC and Exec Co timings are variable at their discretion.
- Proposed Resumption can be discontinued before or after objection by Project Delegate, or if it does not receive Ministerial approval.
- Proposed Resumption may be amended at anytime prior to Ministerial approval but restarts the Notice of Intention process unless amendment is agreed with land owner.
- NIR process expires if a TOLN Application is not formally lodged with Minister Office within 12 months of the date of the original NIR issued.
