





PLAN - LOWER SUPPORT ARM FOR SINGLE BANNER








POLE MOUNTING BRACKET DETAIL FOR SINGLE BANNER - UPPER AND LOWER SUPPORT ARMS

NOTES:

- 1. SCOPE: This drawing provides installation and support details for affixing permitted single or double banners on permitted TMR Base Plate Mounted road lighting poles in accordance with TN69 Banners on Light Poles.
- 2. The permitted banner configurations that may be installed on permitted road lighting poles are specified in TN69.
- 3. THIRD PARTY PROPONENTS intending to install banners on TMR assets shall seek the required approvals as specified in TN69.
- 4. CLEARANCE HEIGHTS to lower support arm shall be as specified in TN69.
- 5. STEELWORK shall be fabricated to MRTS78. Steel plate shall be Grade 250 minimum to AS/NZS 3678. CHS tube shall be Grade C350L0 to AS/NZS 1163. Steel plate and CHS shall be hot-dip galvanized to AS/NZS 4680. Prior to galvanizing, all weld splatter and welding slag shall be removed. Galvanized eyenuts WLL 0.34t to DIN 582. Bolts Class 8.8 to AS/NZS 1252 and hot dip galvanized to AS 1214. Galvanized chain shall be Grade T to AS 2321. Stainless Steel round bar to ASTM A276.
- 6. WELDING symbols to conform to AS 1101.3. AS 1101.3. All welding shall be SP category to AS 1554.1. Welding consumables shall be controlled hydrogen type: G493 to AS/NZS ISO 14341-B or T493 to AS/NZS ISO 17632-B.
- 7. DIMENSIONS are in millimetres.
