Queenslanders urged to visit QLDTraffic for latest road closure information during severe weather events

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is reminding Queenslanders that the most reliable and up-to-date information pertaining to road closures can be found through QLDTraffic.

TMR is reminding Queenslanders to visit QLDTraffic.qld.gov.au for all traffic alerts, road closures and condition updates for major roads in Queensland.

Members of the public can also download the QLDTraffic app or call 13 19 40.

TMR continues to urge the public to exercise extra caution on the roads with wet weather that is currently impacting the Far North, North Queensland and Mackay Whitsundays regions.

TMR is currently urging motorists to limit all road use for non-essential travel, as conditions are constantly changing.

If travel is necessary, road users are being reminded to drive to conditions and follow the directions of traffic controllers and temporary signage.

Road users are also being reminded that “if it’s flooded, forget it”, as multiple weather systems bring with them heavy rain and flooding throughout Northern Queensland.

Given the rapidly changing weather conditions and the variable rainfall intensity and locations, road closures continue to be intermittent and hard to predict.
