IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

A person engaged as a Special Event Traffic Marshal must undertake traffic control duties in accordance with the Special Event Approved Procedure issued by Department of Transport and Main Roads. (Section 126A of the Transport Operations (Road Use Management - Accreditation and other provisions) Regulation 2015

An Event Traffic Marshal must only control traffic at locations denoted on the Traffic Guidance Scheme for the permitted Special Event.

An Event Traffic Marshal must carry this Notice with them at all times while undertaking traffic control activities associated with the permitted Special Event.

The authorisation of an Event Traffic Marshal to control traffic expires at the conclusion of the permitted Special Event (if not revoked earlier).
