Duplication works to start on Beaudesert–Beenleigh Road

- Works will soon commence to duplicate Beaudesert–Beenleigh Road between Mount Warren Boulevard and Tallagandra Road, Mount Warren Park.
- Construction of additional lanes will improve traffic flow, safety and reduce congestion for Logan residents.
- The \$20 million project has been jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland governments.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will soon commence works to duplicate a section of Beaudesert–Beenleigh Road between Mount Warren Boulevard and Tallagandra Road, Mount Warren Park.

Motorists are set to benefit as the road is upgraded from two to four lanes helping to improve traffic flow and reduce congestion in both directions and lower the likelihood of crashes.

The project will also deliver upgraded footpaths and shared paths, adding on-road bike lanes and improve drainage along the stretch of road for better flood immunity in the area.

Residents will also benefit from the upgrade with a noise barrier being installed on the eastern side of Beaudesert–Beenleigh Road to reduce noise coming from the important arterial road.

The \$20 million project has been jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland governments in a 50:50 split.

Construction is expected to commence February 2025.
