Dickabram Bridge to close for an extended period

The Dickabram Bridge on Miva Road, north of Gympie, will be closed from 3 February until late 2025 as the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) continues its comprehensive program of rehabilitation works on the heritage listed bridge.

Built in 1887, the 207-metre rail and road bridge is the oldest remaining bridge of its kind, with works being undertaken to replace deteriorating components of the bridge with safer and more durable materials.

Detours will be in place during this time and motorists are advised to plan ahead and allow extra travel time for their journey.

Signage will be used to notify road users in advance of works commencing.
