Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway

## Notice to motorists

### Night works in Tanawha and Sippy Downs for asphalt works

Construction on the jointly-funded Bruce Highway Upgrade – Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway (CR2SM) is progressing well. The \$932 million project is jointly-funded with the Australian Government committing \$745.6 million and the Queensland Government committing \$186.4 million.

Residents and motorists are advised that traffic changes will continue to occur on major and local roads to facilitate ongoing construction works.

From **21 February 2021**, three work areas along the Sunshine Motorway, entry and exit ramps and local roads in Tanawha and Sippy Downs will be completed with the final layer of open grade asphalt and linemarking. Each work area will take approximately one week with areas constructed intermittently over the next six weeks (weather and construction conditions permitting).

### What to expect

#### Traffic detours and lane closures:

- Temporary ramp closures and detours to allow for asphalt works, signage and line marking, reduced speed limits, changes to traffic flow and short-term traffic disruptions.
- Motorists are advised to follow directional signage and allow extra travel time.

#### Temporary lighting and audible noise

- Heavy machinery will be in use and nearby residents should expect audible noise.
- Lighting towers will be used to light the area at night.
- Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during night working hours.

#### Working hours

Night works will be required to complete these works. The project's working hours are:

- **Night works:** Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am.
- **Day works:** Monday to Saturday, 6am to 6pm.

It is important to note that these activities are dependent on weather conditions.
