

Pacific Motorway (M1) – Oxenford Interchange (Exit 57) Upgrade

Removal of right turn movements and new U-turn opens

28 February 2020

The project will reach a significant milestone when the new U-turn facility on Tamborine–Oxenford Road opens to road users in the coming days.

From late March 2020, the right turn from Old Pacific Highway (northbound) onto the interchange and the right turn from Heathwood Drive (southbound) onto Tamborine–Oxenford Road will be permanently removed.

To travel east onto the interchange and access the M1 North, M1 South or Hope Island Road, road users travelling north on Old Pacific Highway will need to use:

- the new U-turn facility on Tamborine–Oxenford Road; or
- the roundabout at Leo Graham Way.

Road users travelling south on Heathwood Drive will need to travel straight ahead onto Old Pacific Highway to Leo Graham Way to travel west.

With the right turns removed it will mean improved traffic flow through the interchange with simplified signals at this location.

Signage will be in place to direct motorists.

It is important to note that this work schedule depends on weather, site and contractor conditions and may change without notice.

What to expect

- Realigning the intersection of Old Pacific Highway, Tamborine–Oxenford Road and Heathwood Drive to suit new traffic movements.
- Excavation and earthworks to construct additional eastbound and westbound lanes.
- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed and some lane closures.
- Lights during night works.
- Every effort will be made to minimise construction impacts on local residents and businesses.

Your patience is appreciated during the construction of this important infrastructure upgrade.

Work hours

- Work will generally take place Monday to Friday during off-peak travel times and as required on Saturdays.
- Due to high traffic volumes and for safety reasons, some work must be carried out at night and will take place Sunday to Friday from 7pm to 4am.
