

Altandi station park 'n' ride upgrade

Mains Road and Gundooee Street, Sunnybank

Overview

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is planning to upgrade and expand the park 'n' ride at Altandi station.

The proposed plans include a new park 'n' ride facility on Gundooee Street, a new kiss 'n' ride facility, more accessible parking spaces and new bike storage facilities within the existing park 'n' ride on Mains Road, as well as a new sheltered walkway that extends from the railway station to Mains Road.

Delivering these customer improvements will assist in achieving a connected, integrated network and make public transport an attractive option for everyone.

Park 'n' ride plays a key role in the South East Queensland public transport network as they connect a diverse range of customers to public transport, help reduce traffic congestion and improve access for those with mobility difficulties.

Benefits

The Altandi station park 'n' ride upgrade and expansion will provide numerous benefits to the community, including:

- increasing the number of parking bays by approximately 50 spaces
- safer pedestrian movements through the provision of a new kiss 'n' ride facility within the existing park 'n' ride
- improved passenger amenities, experience and access, including a new sheltered walkway between the railway station to Mains Road
- improved safety for park 'n' ride users through new lighting and CCTV
