

Bruce Highway—Cairns Southern Access Corridor Stage 3: Edmonton to Gordonvale Project

Night works - Temporary closure of Maher Road intersection with the Bruce Highway

Night works will close access to the Bruce Highway at Maher Road, Gordonvale on 1 February 2021*

As part of works for the Bruce Highway - Cairns Southern Access Corridor - Stage 3: Edmonton to Gordonvale (E2G) project, Maher Road access to the Bruce Highway will be temporarily closed. This closure will be in place from 1 February 2021.

Night works will be required to install barriers to close access from Bruce Highway to Maher Road.

The temporary closure of the Maher Road will allow construction of the Bruce Highway southbound carriageways, pedestrian path, relocation of the Queensland Rail North Coast Line, Cairns Road connection and the Maher Road offramp.

What does this mean for traffic?

Access to residential and business properties located within Maher Road will be maintained via Draper Road, Cairns Road, Highland Road.

All traffic movements to access the Bruce Highway in this area will be via Draper Road.

The new configuration of Maher Road is expected to reopen late 2021, weather permitting.

Access from the Bruce Highway will not open until the south bound lane is complete in 2022, weather permitting.

What you can expect during works:

Hours of work

- Day time construction will occur 7am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday*, weather permitting.

Noise and vibration

- Noise from machinery and vehicles may be present while works are underway. Noise and vibration monitoring will be ongoing.

Vehicles

- Truck deliveries of bridge piles will occur along Thompson Road, Page Road, Hill Road and Warner Road from 16 February 2021* to facilitate these works.
