



Bruce Highway—Cairns Southern Access Corridor **Stage 3: Edmonton to Gordonvale Project**

Night works - Northbound slow lane of overtaking lanes between Castlereagh Street and Maitland Road

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) advises of night works scheduled for 2 February 2021*.

As part of works for the Bruce Highway - Cairns Southern Access Corridor - Stage 3: Edmonton to Gordonvale (E2G) project, the northbound slow lane of the overtaking lanes between Castlereagh Street and Maitland Road will close to traffic for the duration of the project. The closure will be in place from 2 February 2021.

On the evening of 2 February 2021, crews will carry out works for the closure, weather permitting. Additional works to close the lane will occur on 3 and 4 February during normal working hours.

The closure of the slow lane will allow construction of the Cane Rail, Bruce Highway service road and new duplicated Bruce Highway.

What you can expect during works

Traffic control

- Traffic changes, including reduced speed limits, temporary signage, changes to traffic flow and short-term traffic disruptions.

Noise

- Audible noise from construction activities and heavy machinery may occur. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement.

Construction activities

- Nearby residents and businesses can expect increased construction activities, which may cause dust, light and vibration. Impacts will be monitored and minimised where possible.

Access

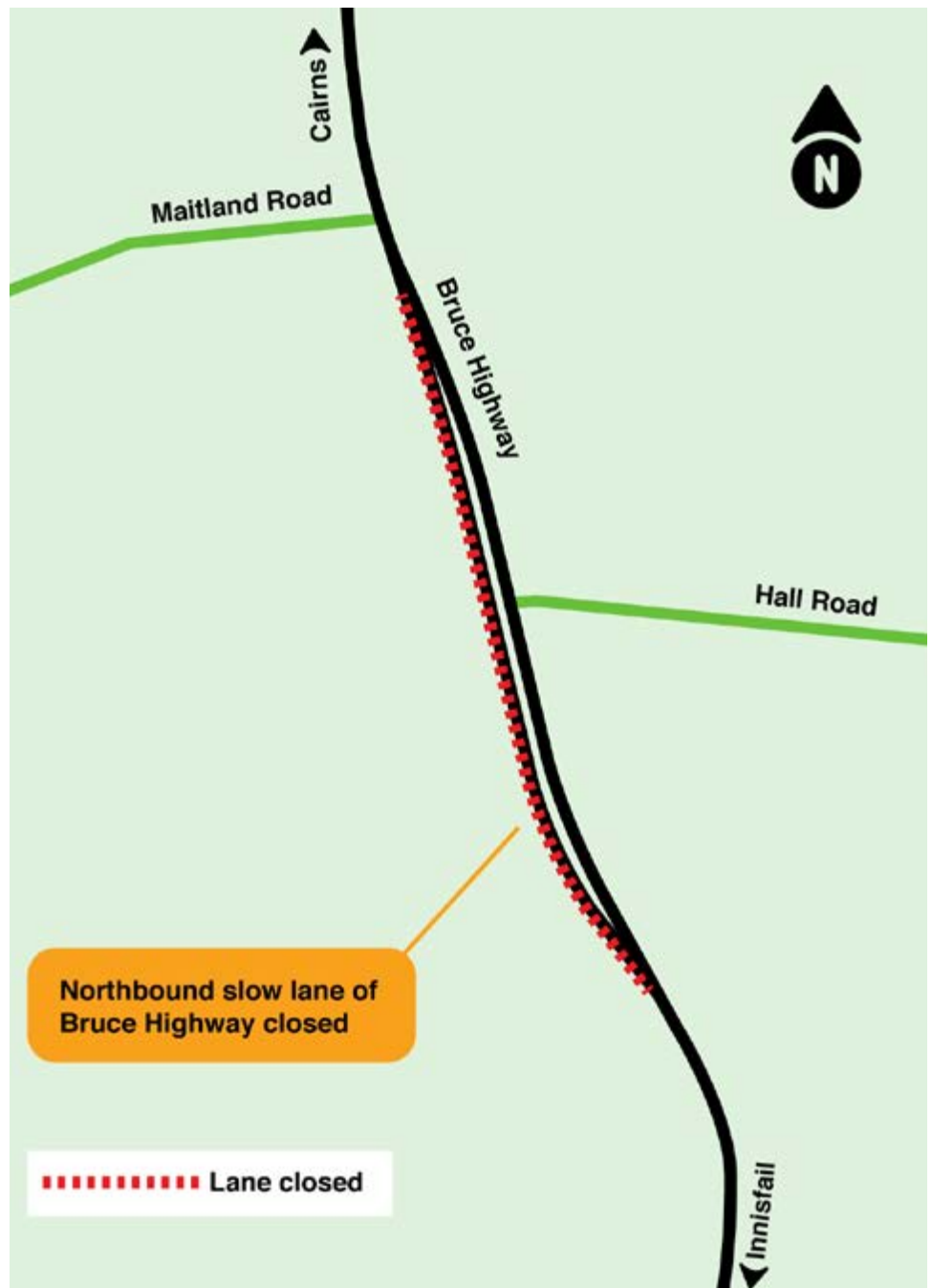
- Access to properties will be maintained and negotiated with directly affected landowners and businesses.
