New dedicated pedestrian and bike riding bridge between Tanawha and Sippy Downs open to the public

Construction on the jointly-funded Bruce Highway Upgrade – Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway (CR2SM) is progressing well. The \$932 million project is jointly-funded with the Australian Government committing \$745.6 million and the Queensland Government committing \$186.4 million.

A new dedicated pedestrian and bike riding bridge between Tanawha and Sippy Downs is now open to active transport users.

The bridge provides a safe connection between Tanawha and Sippy Downs for active transport users, improving access to the educational, business and residential precincts at Sippy Downs.

This new dedicated pedestrian and bike riding bridge is part of more than nine kilometres of dedicated lanes and pathways for active transport users being constructed as part of the CR2SM project.

Once complete, the active transport facilities will extend from Caloundra Road at Meridan Plains, through the new Diverging Diamond Interchange to link with Steve Irwin Way at Glenview, and provide a major new pathway running the entire length of the new Frizzo Connection Road from Glenview in the south to Sippy Downs in the north.

The active transport bridge is the first section of this active transport network to open. The remaining sections will be complete by mid-2021, weather permitting.
