Bruce Highway southbound traffic diverted onto final carriageway

Construction on the jointly-funded Bruce Highway Upgrade – Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway (CR2SM) is nearing completion. The \$932 million project is jointly-funded with the Australian Government committing \$745.6 million and the Queensland Government committing \$186.4 million.

After **21 April 2021** (weather permitting), the Bruce Highway southbound carriageway will be realigned from Aussie World, Palmview to Exit 188 (the exit to Caloundra and Landsborough) while final asphalt and linemarking is completed.

The new carriageway will initially provide two lanes for southbound traffic, with an additional third lane anticipated to open by mid-2021 (weather permitting), with finishing works to follow.

Please note – the Bruce Highway southbound entry ramp from Pignata Road will be permanently closed in May 2021. All local traffic travelling southbound from Palmview and Glenview will travel along the newly constructed Frizzo Connection Road to connect to Steve Irwin Way, Caloundra Road or the Bruce Highway (refer to map overleaf).

What to expect

Traffic detours and lane closures:

- Prior to the traffic changes, detours will be in place to facilitate the work.
- Temporary lane closures will also occur to allow for pavement works, signage, guardrail installation and line marking.
- Traffic changes may be in place near work areas including reduced speed limits, road shoulder and lane closures, changes to traffic flow and short-term traffic disruption.
- Traffic signals/traffic controllers will be on-site to manage traffic flow.
- The final layer of open grade asphalt will be laid prior to the third lane opening in May 2021 (weather permitting).

Audible noise:

- Heavy machinery will be in use and nearby residents should expect audible noise.
- Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during day and night working hours.

Working hours

Both day and night works will be required to complete these works.

The project's working hours are:

- **Night works:** Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am.
- **Day works:** Monday to Saturday, 6am to 6pm.

It is important to note that these activities are dependent on weather conditions.


