Notice to motorists and residents

Nine new and improved bus stop facilities between Steve Irwin Way and Tanawha Tourist Drive

Construction on the jointly-funded Bruce Highway Upgrade – Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway (CR2SM) is nearing completion. The project is jointly-funded with the Australian Government committing \$745.6 million and the Queensland Government committing \$186.4 million.

From **Monday 24 May 2021**, nine bus stops will open to the public as part of the CR2SM project. The new facilities include a range of upgraded and new bus stops along local connection roads. See example artist impression below.

These new changes will increase service coverage and improve reliability to the current bus network.

What to expect

New locations

- Some bus stops were temporarily relocated or closed during construction. Existing bus stops have been upgraded and the new bus stops have been installed to meet current standards. Refer to the map overleaf for the new locations.

TransLink timetables

School bus stops

The new bus stops will also accommodate school bus drop-off and pick-up.

Working hours

Both day and night works will be required to complete these works.

The project's working hours are:

- Night works:** Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am.
- Day works:** Monday to Saturday, 6am to 6pm.

It is important to note that these activities are dependent on weather conditions.

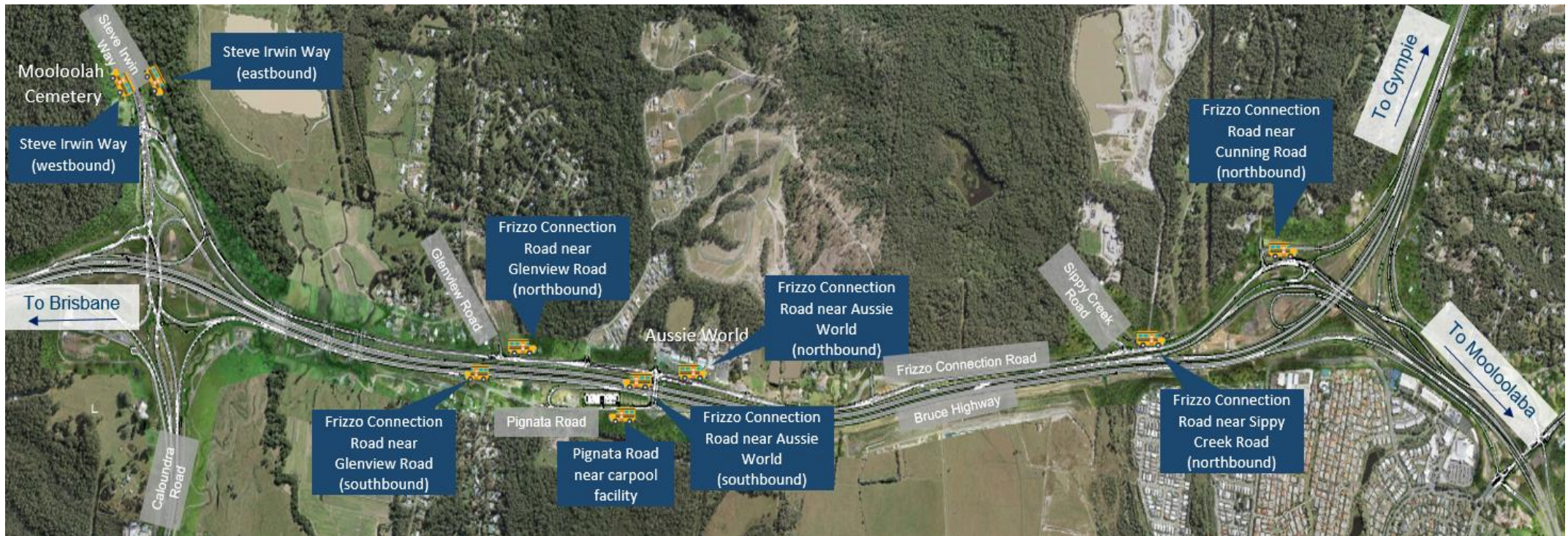
