Deception Bay Road Interchange

New Settlement Road temporary closure – extended to Friday, 9 July

The Bruce Highway Upgrade – Deception Bay Road Interchange project will deliver two new parallel bridges over the Bruce Highway, upgrade two signalised intersections on Deception Bay Road, increase the length and capacity of the existing entry and exit ramps and provide new infrastructure for pedestrians and bike riders.

New Settlement Road temporary closure – extended

Due to inclement weather the closure on New Settlement Road between Old Gympie Road and Marks Road has been extended with the road now being opened on Friday, 9 July at 11pm.

The detour via Old Gympie Road, Pitt Road and Burpengary Road will be available. Refer to the map overleaf.

Local access will be maintained for residents, deliveries and services into this area. Emergency services access will also be maintained on this section of New Settlement Road.

The temporary road closure was required so extensive drainage works near the intersection of Old Gympie Road and New Settlement Road and constrained roadworks activities near the intersection of Marks Road and New Settlement Road could be undertaken along this road section safely and efficiently.

The project team will continue to work closely with Moreton Bay Regional Council and local residents to minimise impacts as much as possible.

Thank you for your on-going patience and cooperation during these works.

What to expect:

- **Traffic detour:** Traffic will continue to be detoured via Old Gympie Road, Pitt Road and Burpengary Road. Refer to map overleaf. Motorists are advised to follow signage and the instructions of traffic controllers and allow extra travel time.
- **Night works:** In addition to day works, night works will be required during the temporary closure period. Control measures will be implemented to minimise the impact of construction activities on the local community.
- **Audible noise and dust:** Audible noise and dust from construction activities, heavy machinery and other vehicles can be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during work hours and measures will be implemented to minimise dust generation.
- **Access:** Local access will be provided at all times for properties on the western end (Marks Road) of the New Settlement Road closure area. Traffic control will be in place to assist.
- **Emergency vehicle access:** Emergency services access will be maintained on this section of New Settlement Road from both directions.

Working hours:

- During night works, control measures will be implemented to minimise the impact of activities on the local community.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
