The Bruce Highway Upgrade – Deception Bay Road Interchange (DBRIU) project will deliver two new parallel bridges over the Bruce Highway, upgrade two signalised intersections on Deception Bay Road, increase the length and capacity of the existing entry and exit ramps and provide new infrastructure for pedestrians and bike riders.

December overview

There will be a marked increase in construction activity across the project site during December with works including vegetation clearing, earthworks, piling and drainage. Note, there are no planned works between 17 December 2020 and 3 January 2021 over the Christmas period.

Works planned for December include:

Old Gympie Road

- Night works for drainage and earthworks will continue into early December.
- Traffic control will be setup and lanes will be realigned to allow for footpath works.
- All other works in this area will be carried out during the day.

Bruce Highway

- Earthworks, piling and concrete works for the new bridge will continue in December.
- The planned works will be conducted during the day.
- An 80km/hr speed limit will be in place.

Deception Bay Road

- Day works will continue in this area for earthworks, drainage, pavement and asphalt activities.
- In mid-December there will be one to two evenings of night works along Deception Bay Road.
- Earthworks from Arethusa College to Tallowood Drive will commence in December. Note, works in front of the College will be undertaken during the school holidays.

Eastern Service Road

- There will be temporary single lane closures on the Eastern Service Road during December for earthworks.

What to expect:

Night works

- Old Gympie Road night works will continue through to early December and will include lane closures, earthworks and asphalt works.
- Some vegetation clearing works will be conducted at night in early December.
- There will be night works on Deception Bay Road for one to two nights during mid-December.

Traffic changes

- The lane alignment of Old Gympie Road will change, with signs and barriers installed.
- Ongoing lane closures on Eastern Service Road for day and night works during December.
- Arethusa College driveway works will be undertaken during the December school holidays.

Working hours

Day works will be undertaken wherever possible. However, night works will be required where the works are in close proximity to live traffic. This will ensure the safety of motorists and workers.

Night works:

- between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.

Day works:

- between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday
- between 7am and 2pm on Saturday.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
