May 2021 project update

The Bruce Highway Upgrade – Deception Bay Road Interchange project will deliver two new parallel bridges over the Bruce Highway, upgrade two signalised intersections on Deception Bay Road, increase the length and capacity of the existing entry and exit ramps and provide new infrastructure for pedestrians and bike riders.

What's happening in May?

During May 2021, construction will continue across the site. Major works will include installation of large bridge girders on the first Deception Bay Road bridge over the Bruce Highway. This activity is planned to begin in late May and go for approximately 12 nights.

Works planned:

Bruce Highway bridge night works

- Girder installation on the first bridge across the Bruce Highway are planned to begin at night from late May.
- Motorists should expect temporary lane closures and full closures of the Bruce Highway during these works, with minor detours via entry and exit ramps.
- Local detours may also be required during the girder installation activities.

New Settlement Road

- Earthworks, drainage and road pavement works will continue on New Settlement Road throughout May.
- All works in and around driveways will be discussed with property owners prior to works commencing.
- The speed limit on New Settlement Road will remain at 40km/h through the work zone.

Deception Bay Road

- Earthworks, drainage and road pavement works will occur on Deception Bay Road during May.
- Night works are required to remove the centre median and undertake pavement works.
- The speed limit on Deception Bay Road will remain at 40km/h through the work zone.

Old Gympie Road

- Earthworks, drainage and road pavement works will occur on Old Gympie Road during May.
- Night works and traffic changes will be undertaken at the New Settlement Road intersection.

- Large vehicles and construction traffic will be in the area.
- The speed limit on Old Gympie Road will remain at 40km/h through the work zone.

Eastern Service Road

- Earthworks, drainage and road pavement works will occur on the Eastern Service Road during May.
- Single lane closures will be in place during these works.
- The speed limit on the Eastern Service Road will remain at 40km/h through the work zone.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.

What to expect:

- **Traffic control:** Increased local traffic changes will be in place including reduced speed limits, temporary lane closures, traffic detours and minor traffic disruptions. Traffic controllers may be present to assist and direct road users. Priority access through the work zone will be given to emergency vehicles, wherever safe to do so.
- **Night works:** Night works are outlined under 'works planned' and will also include underground service installation works at the intersections of Old Gympie Road/New Settlement Road and Deception Bay Road/Eastern Service Road.
- **Audible noise and dust:** Audible noise and dust from construction activities, heavy machinery and other vehicles can be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during work hours. Measures will be implemented to minimise dust generation.
- **Access:** Access to residential properties and businesses will be maintained as needed.

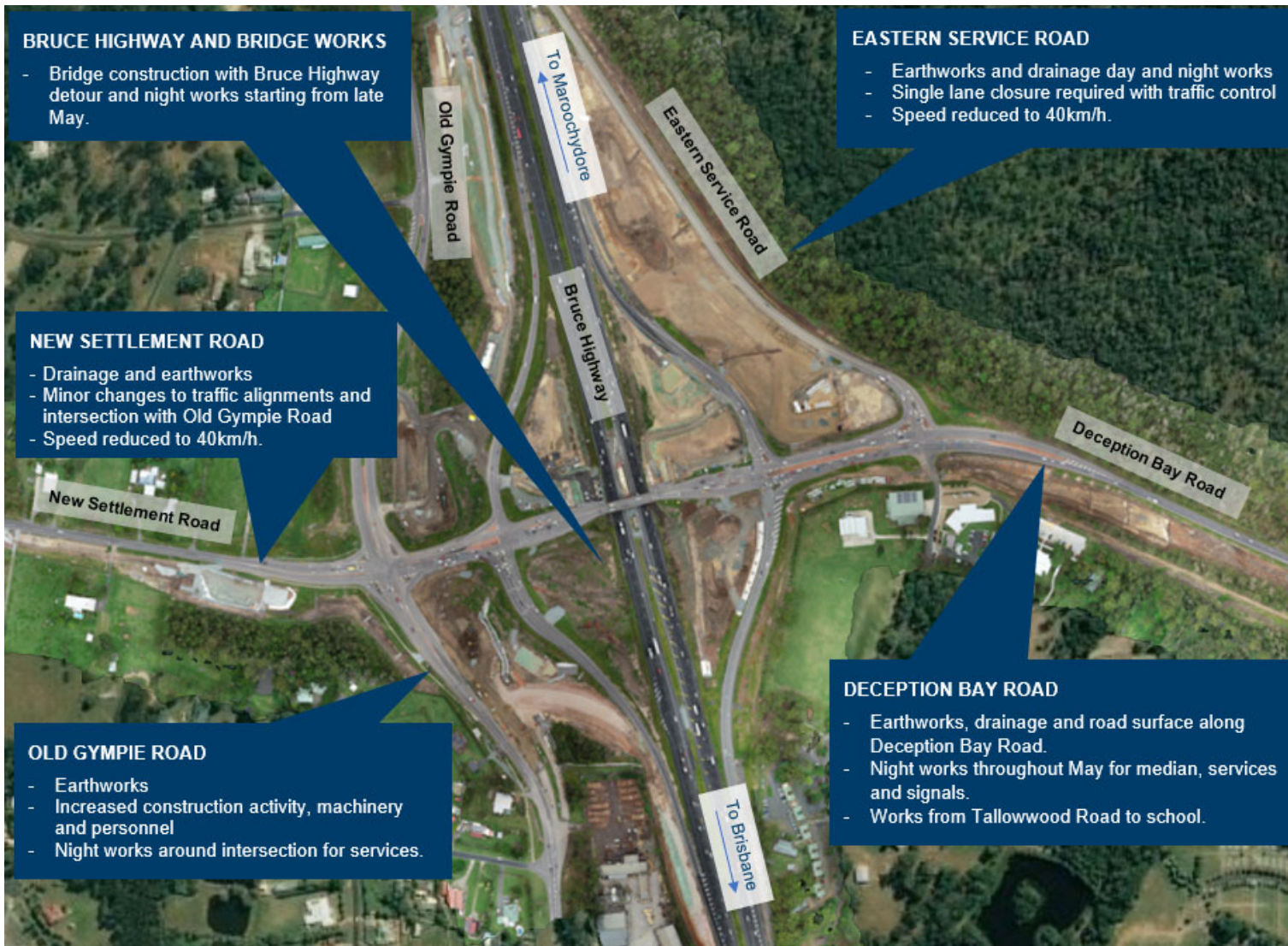

Day works:

- between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday
- between 7am and 5pm on Saturday.

Night works:

between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday
