## Notice to motorists

### Maroochydoore Road Interchange

The Department of Transport and Main Roads would like to advise that major construction work to upgrade and signalise the Maroochydoore Road Interchange **has now commenced**. Work on the upgrade is expected to be completed by the **end of 2022** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

### Key features

Upgrading this busy interchange will deliver improved safety for road users, increased traffic capacity and new active transport connectivity.

Key features include:

- converting the existing roundabout to a **fully controlled, signalised interchange** - including realigning the approaches to improve sight lines and safety
- constructing a **new four-lane, eastbound bridge** over the Bruce Highway from Nambour Connection Road to Maroochydoore Road
- **extending and widening all entry and exit ramps** to the interchange – including additional traffic lanes to Nambour Connection Road and Maroochydoore Road
- delivering **new active transport facilities** for bike riders and pedestrians through the interchange connecting from Nambour Connection Road to Mons Road
- landscaping and visual improvements.

### Working hours

Both day and night works will be required to complete these works.

- **Night works:** Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am
- **Day works:** Monday to Saturday, 6am to 6pm.

### What to expect:

- **Major construction work:** this will include bulk earthworks, new bridge construction, realigning and constructing new traffic lanes, installing new traffic signal infrastructure, demolition of original eastbound bridge, asphaltting and line marking.
- **Changed traffic conditions:** traffic arrangements will change regularly to provide safe work areas for construction workers and to maintain the safety of motorists.
- **Temporary lighting and audible noise:** heavy machinery will be in use and nearby residents should expect some audible noise. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during day and night working hours. Lighting towers will be used to light the area at night.

**Motorists are advised to obey reduced speed limits, follow directional signage and importantly, allow extra travel time.**
