## Notice to motorists

### Mons Road Interchange

The Department of Transport and Main Roads would like to advise that work to upgrade the Mons Road Interchange will commence in **mid-October 2020**, with the bulk of construction expected to be completed by mid-2021 (weather and construction conditions permitting).

### Key features

Upgrading this busy interchange will deliver improved safety for motorists, increased traffic capacity, improved flood immunity and active transport connectivity.

The key features of the upgrade include:

- an additional traffic lane under the Bruce Highway – resulting in four traffic lanes
- upgraded signalised intersections at Mons Road and Chevallum Road – these signals will be synchronised to maximise traffic flow, particularly during peak periods
- an additional northbound traffic lane on Chevallum Road – resulting in two lanes for right-turning traffic onto Mons Road
- upgraded drainage infrastructure
- provisions for active transport – including on-road cycle paths under the Bruce Highway and at both signalised intersections.

### Construction activities

Construction activities will involve:

- bulk earthworks including relocating underground services and installing new drainage structures
- excavating and demolishing existing retaining walls (under the Bruce Highway) and constructing new retaining walls
- constructing new traffic lanes, installing new traffic signal infrastructure, asphaltting and line marking.

### Working hours

The majority of construction work will need to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are lower. Day work will continue in work areas with less impact to traffic.

#### Night work:

- Between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.

#### Day work:

- Between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday.

### What to expect:

- **Changed traffic conditions:** traffic arrangements will change regularly to provide safe work areas for construction workers. This will include temporary lane and road closures and intermittent detours at night. Traffic controllers and police will be present to assist motorists if required. Motorists are advised to follow directional signage and allow extra travel time. **Priority access through the work zone will be given to emergency vehicles, where possible.**
- **Increased construction traffic and workers:** Nearby businesses can expect to see increased construction traffic and workers in the area.
- **Temporary lighting and audible noise:** Lighting towers will be used to light the area at night. Audible noise from construction activities and heavy machinery can be expected.

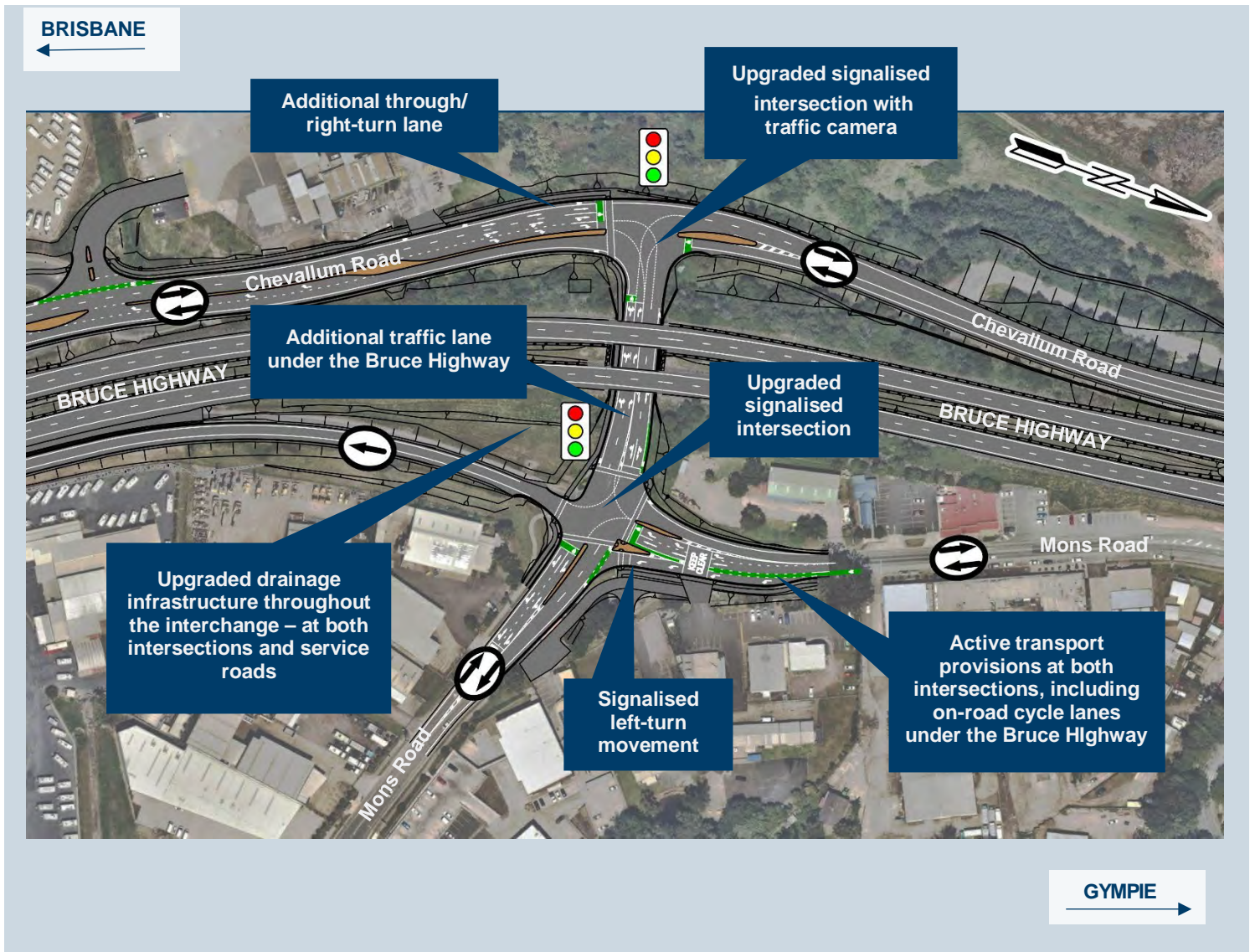
