## Works at the Bruce Highway southbound exit to Maroochydore Road

The Department of Transport and Main Roads would like to advise that works to widen the southbound exit ramp from the Bruce Highway to Maroochydore Road, have commenced.

These works form a key component of the broader upgrade to the Maroochydore Road interchange, which is expected to be completed by the **end of 2022** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

### Key features

The southbound exit ramp from the Bruce Highway to Maroochydore Road is currently one lane and often experiences heavy traffic congestion and delays.

As part of the Bruce Highway Upgrade – Maroochydore Road and Mons Road Interchanges project, entry and exit ramps to the Maroochydore Road interchange will be extended and widened. This will improve road safety, increase transport capacity and improve travel times.

Works have now commenced to widen the southbound exit ramp from one lane to four lanes which will provide two left-turn lanes to Maroochydore Road and two through lanes to the interchange.

Construction vehicles, including heavy and light vehicles, are entering and exiting the work zone by travelling along Maroochydore Road and Stark Lane.

### What to expect:

- **Major construction works:** this will involve bulk earthworks including the installation of soil and rock fill, installing new drainage and electrical infrastructure, road pavement construction, asphaltting and line marking.
- **Increased construction traffic:** residents can expect increased construction traffic travelling to and from the work zone. Construction vehicles will obey all road rules. Environmental controls will be implemented at the entry and exit points to facilitate construction vehicle access to the work zone.
- **Temporary lighting and audible noise:** heavy machinery will be in use and nearby residents should expect some audible noise. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during day and night working hours. Lighting towers will be used to light the area at night.

### Working hours

The majority of work in this area will be undertaken during the day, however, some night works will be required.

#### Day works, ongoing

- Between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday.

#### Intermittent night work will be required

- Between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.
