Notice to motorists

Bruce Highway southbound diversion over Eudlo Creek at Forest Glen

Construction of the Bruce Highway Upgrade – Maroochydore Road and Mons Road interchanges project is progressing well.

A key project milestone has recently been reached, with the completion of the new bridge over Eudlo Creek on the eastern side of the Bruce Highway. This bridge forms part of the new eastern service road which will link the Maroochydore Road and Mons Road interchanges and separate local traffic from highway traffic.

From **Sunday 18 July 2021**, (weather and construction conditions permitting), Bruce Highway southbound traffic will be diverted onto a new section of the eastern service road over Eudlo Creek. This two-lane section of road is approximately 500 metres in length and will enable motorists to re-join the existing highway before the Mons Road exit (Exit 200). This diversion will enable the construction contractor to install major drainage infrastructure under the existing southbound carriageway of the Bruce Highway.

This traffic change will be in place until mid-2022, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Motorists will still be able use Exit 200 to travel to Mons Road and access to businesses will be maintained.

We thank the local community for your patience and cooperation during these works.

Working hours

Both day and night works will be required to complete these works.

The project's working hours are:

- **Day works:** Monday to Saturday, 6am to 6pm.
- **Night works:** Sunday to Thursday, 6.30pm to 5am.

It is important to note that these activities are dependent on weather conditions.

What to expect:

- **Traffic changes:** Signage and traffic barriers will be in place to safely direct motorists onto the new section of road.
- **Audible noise:** Audible noise from construction activities can be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during work hours.
- **Increased construction traffic:** Residents near the work area can expect increased construction traffic, including large trucks travelling near the work zones.
- **Temporary lighting:** Lighting towers will be used to light work areas at night. The lighting towers will be positioned away from oncoming traffic and residential properties.
- **Access:** Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

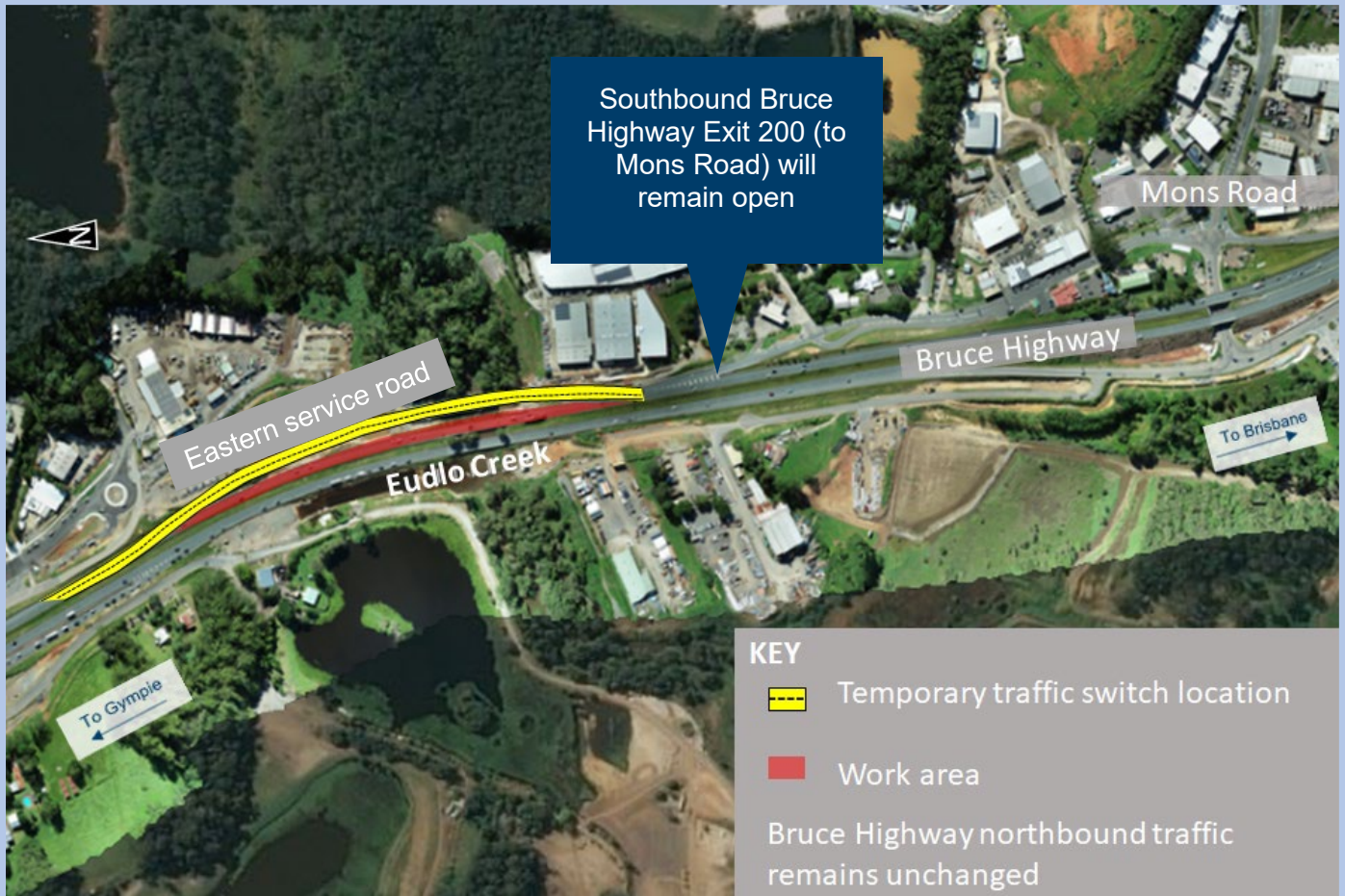
