

Coomera station park 'n' ride upgrade

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is investigating options to increase parking capacity at the park 'n' ride facility at Coomera station.

Concept designs have been prepared to allow more people to easily connect with frequent public transport options including train and bus, helping to manage congestion on the road network in this growing region.

Project benefits

The project includes:

- close to 500 new parking spaces
- new signalised access from Foxwell Road to the eastern carpark
- kiss 'n' ride space for quick drop-offs and pick-ups
- landscaping with hardy, low-maintenance plants to enhance the area
- lighting and security measures
- additional people with disability parking spaces
- improved bus operations with new bus layover

New carparks are proposed be built on vacant land to the east of the train station backing onto Foxwell Road and to the north-west of the station on Railway Road.

As well as utilising these vacant blocks TMR intends to reconfigure some of the existing carparks to maximise the space.

Timeline

- The project is currently in business case phase. Business case is proposed to be complete by early 2021.
- TMR proposes to deliver the upgrade in stages to minimise the impact to commuters utilising the park 'n' ride.
