Pacific Motorway (M1): Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill upgrade V1 Veloway



Overview

The Veloway (V1) is a 20 kilometre, dedicated cycleway that provides a safe and efficient route for bike riders between Lower River Terrace, South Brisbane, and Underwood.

The V1 is being extended from Eight Mile Plains to Slacks Creek as part of the M1: Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill (EMP2DH) upgrade.

Master planning for a complete cycle link and to close network gaps between Brisbane and the New South Wales border, is underway.

The V1 extension will open to riders in stages; the first of which was opened in September 2021, between Eight Mile Plains and Maureen Street, Underwood. Further stages will open as works are completed.

V1 access locations – **EMP2DH upgrade**

Numerous V1 access points that connect existing riding thoroughfares, local recreational facilities, and business/retail outlets will be provided, as follows:

- Logan Road, Eight Mile Plains (near the Gateway Motorway
- Underwood Road (near Eight Mile Plains State School)
- Maureen Street, Underwood (Camelot Park)
- Sports Drive, Underwood
- Springwood Road, Underwood (nearest the M1 bridges)
- Pacific Highway service road, Slacks Creek (Moss Street).

A better integrated, multi modal transport network, contributing to the vitality of Queensland's cities and towns.


