Pacific Motorway (M1) – Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill upgrade Pacific Highway early works

About the upgrade

Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is upgrading the 8-kilometre stretch of M1 from Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill (EMP2DH) as part of a rolling program of M1 upgrades between the Gateway and Logan Motorways.

The EMP2DH upgrade is being delivered in four separate packages of works, with the second package being the Pacific Highway early works upgrade.

This upgrade will increase the capacity of the Pacific Highway western service road and enable widening of the M1 through future upgrade projects – see map overleaf.

TMR recently announced Georgiou Group as the construction contractor for this project, with works due to start in July 2020 and continue until late 2021, conditions permitting.

What to expect

- Permanent removal of on-road parking along the Pacific Highway western service road between Moss Street and Westerway Street
 - The contractor will aim to provide directly impacted businesses with at least two weeks' notice of changes to parking requirements
- Day and night works required to minimise disruption to businesses during operating hours
- Changed traffic conditions including intermittent lane, shoulder and footpath closures
- General increase in workers and construction activities in the area.

Please note that every effort will be made to minimise impacts to residents, businesses and motorists during construction.


