

Springfield Central station park 'n' ride - start of construction

Dear Stakeholder,

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise construction of the Springfield Central station multi-storey park 'n' ride on the corner of Springfield Greenbank Arterial Road and Centenary Highway off-ramp will be commencing soon.

The Queensland Government has committed \$44.5 million to deliver the multi-storey park 'n' ride which will create more parking spaces for the Springfield Central station. Once completed, the total number across the station precinct will total around 1,100 park 'n' ride spaces. It will also improve safety and security for people in and around the station precinct.



Timing:



- Works will commence in late September 2020 and be complete in 2022, construction and weather conditions permitting
- Standard construction hours will be from 6:30am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday
- Selected works will be required to be undertaken at night for the safety of the work crews and to minimise impacts to the road network. Night works will be from 7pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.



Work activities:

- Construction of the multi-storey carpark
- Construction of the entry and exit from the carpark onto Springfield Greenbank Arterial Road
- Safety improvements including installing pedestrian connectivity from the carpark to the station, CCTV cameras and lighting

- Tree and vegetation clearing
- Treatment to existing underground services
- Installation of project safety fencing



Expected impacts:

- Nearby residents and businesses may experience impacts including vibration, dust and lights from construction equipment and machinery and activities onsite
- Noise minimisation measures will be implemented to reduce the impact of construction noise
- Motorists may experience changed traffic conditions, including speed limit restrictions, lane or shoulder closure, and other traffic control measures throughout the work site. Traffic control and signage will be in place as required. Please allow extra time when planning your travel
- Access to the existing station carparks and temporary carpark will be maintained at all times, with detours in place as required
- Construction access may have temporary impacts on pedestrian paths. Detours will be in place as required
- Buses and trains servicing the Springfield Central station will operate as normal during construction

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts on the local community and surrounds. TMR appreciates your patience and cooperation while these important works are carried out.
