

# Early works for the Sumners Road Interchange Upgrade

Dear Stakeholder,

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that underground services relocations for the Sumners Road Interchange Upgrade will be commencing in early 2019.

The Sumners Road Interchange Upgrade will increase traffic capacity through the interchange, provide traffic signals for better traffic management and safer facilities for pedestrians and cyclists with shared pathways and on-road cycle lanes, dedicated crossing facilities and links to the surrounding local network and Centenary Motorway bikeway.

The works are being undertaken as part of the early works for the Sumners Road Interchange Upgrade and are required to allow for future construction activities.

## Timing:

- Works will commence **early-February 2019** and be completed by **late-May 2019**, construction and weather conditions permitting.
- Standard construction hours will be night works from **7.30pm to 5am, Monday to Sunday** and day works **Monday to Sunday from 7am to 5pm**.
- A combination of day and night works will be undertaken. Night works are undertaken in areas close to the road for the safety of the work crew and road users and to minimise the impact to the road network.

## Work will include:

- Relocation of underground Telstra services to allow for future construction activities for the Sumners Road Interchange Upgrade (SRIU).
- Drilling under the Centenary Motorway and Sumners Road.

## Expected impacts:

- Changed traffic conditions may include reduced speed limits, lane or shoulder closures and minor delays.
- There will be access changes to the cycleway and footpath. Traffic control will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists.
- Traffic control and signage will be in place as required. Please allow extra time when planning your travel.
- Nearby residents and businesses may experience short term impacts, including noise from drilling to relocate underground services, dust and lights from construction equipment and machinery in the area.
