

# Veloway 1 (V1) Trinity Lane off-ramp upgrade

December 2021

The Veloway 1 (V1) is a dedicated cycleway running between Lower River Terrace, South Brisbane and Underwood. The 17 kilometre cycleway provides a safe and efficient route for people travelling by bike.

Upgrades to the V1 are being made in stages to remove multiple road crossings and improve safety where on-road crossings still exist.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is developing a planning study to upgrade the V1 connection at Trinity Lane which joins with the local road network via the Woolloongabba bikeway. The project is bound by Trinity Lane, Pacific Motorway off-ramp at Stanley Street.

At present, the existing V1 connection at Trinity Lane is very steep and narrow and at the narrowest section, bike riders are required to dismount their bike to pass through.

The upgraded connection will include a wider path and less steep gradient, making for a safer rider experience. It is likely that some trees and vegetation would be impacted to accommodate this upgrade, and TMR will minimise the loss of greenspace where possible.

During the planning study, TMR will work closely with key stakeholders including Brisbane City Council and Bicycle User Groups.

## Timeline

The planning study is underway and expected to be completed in mid-2022. Future stages of design and construction are subject to further funding and state-wide prioritisation of transport infrastructure investments.
