Flood related roadworks



Reconstruction projects

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is continuing to deliver an extensive program of flood related reconstruction from the 2010, 2011 and 2012 major flood events in the Darling Downs area.

Over the coming months, four individual packages of works will be carried out on the Cunningham Highway, between Warwick and Goondiwindi. These works will range from full road reconstruction projects to fixing small areas of damaged road surfaces.

Changed traffic conditions

Motorists are advised there will be multiple sites in operation across this key route and are reminded to plan their travel to allow for delays.

Traffic signals, traffic controllers, single lane closures and speed restrictions are to be expected at many of these sites.

Transport and Main Roads is working closely with the Queensland Police Service to enforce changes to traffic conditions across our region.

Motorists are urged to pay extra attention around road works and be aware that traffic ahead may have stopped. For motorist and road worker safety please obey all signage and any directions from traffic controllers.

Wide loads

Restrictions for wide loads will also be in place. Operators of heavy vehicles are reminded to check the Conditions of Operation Database (search for 'Conditions of Operation Database') prior to their journey.

Project funding

These works are being delivered under Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA), a joint Australian and Queensland Government initiative. Under NDRRA, the Australian Government provides 75% of the funding, with 25% from the Queensland Government.
