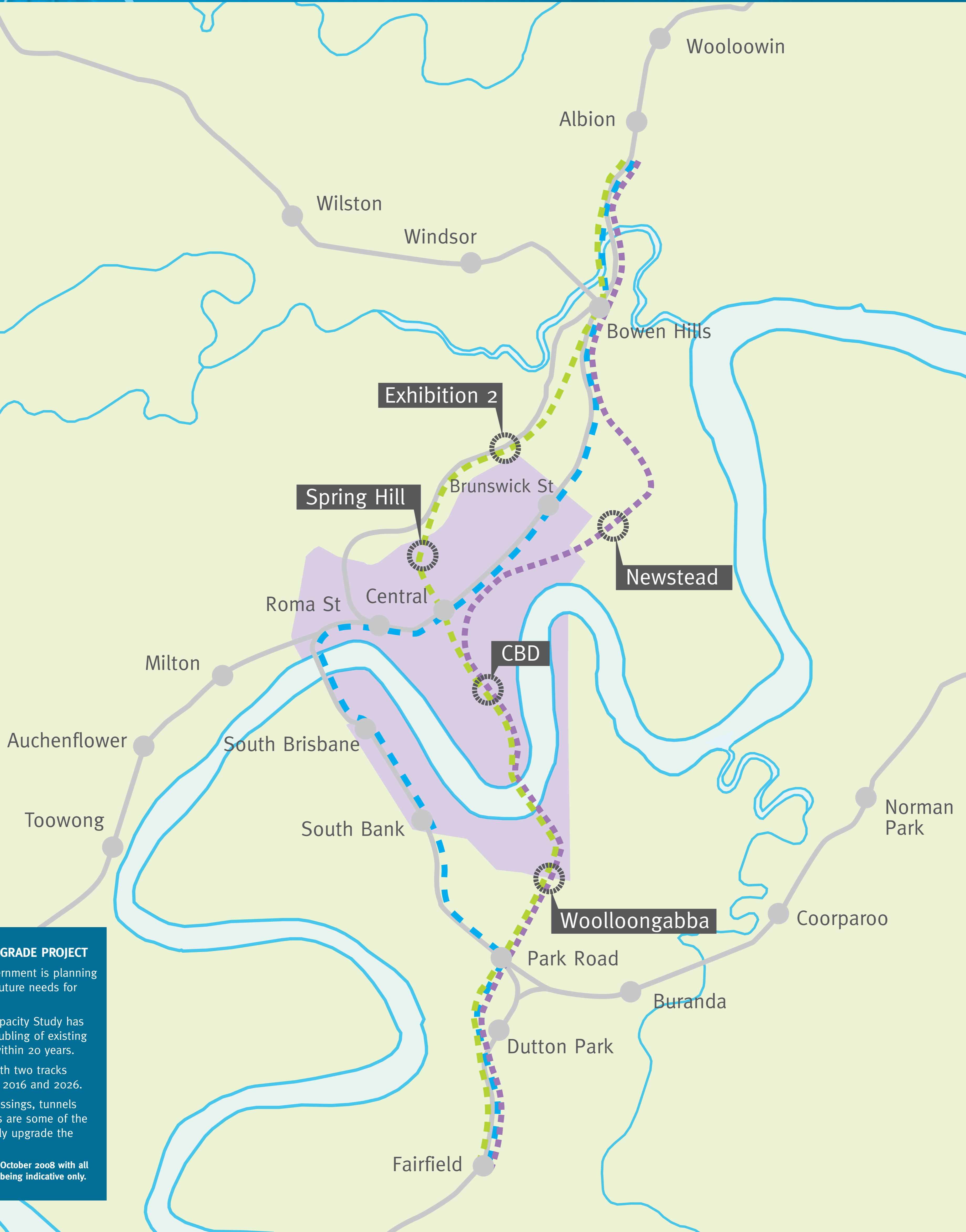




Inner City Rail Upgrade Project



INNER CITY RAIL UPGRADE PROJECT

The Queensland Government is planning an upgrade to meet future needs for inner city rail.

The Inner City Rail Capacity Study has determined that a doubling of existing capacity is required within 20 years.

Two new rail lines, with two tracks each, are planned for 2016 and 2026.

Underground river crossings, tunnels and new CBD stations are some of the options to dramatically upgrade the city's rail network.

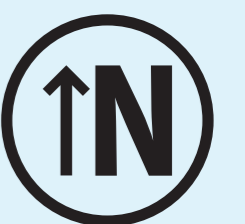
This map was produced in October 2008 with all routes and stations shown being indicative only.
