

# Transport Network Reconstruction Program

## Mount Mee Road reconstruction works

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is undertaking reconstruction works on Mount Mee Road, also known as Brisbane-Woodford Road, to repair damage sustained in early 2013.

TMR will start work in March at the two sites: near Ocean View Road at Ocean View and Duncan Road near Mount Mee.

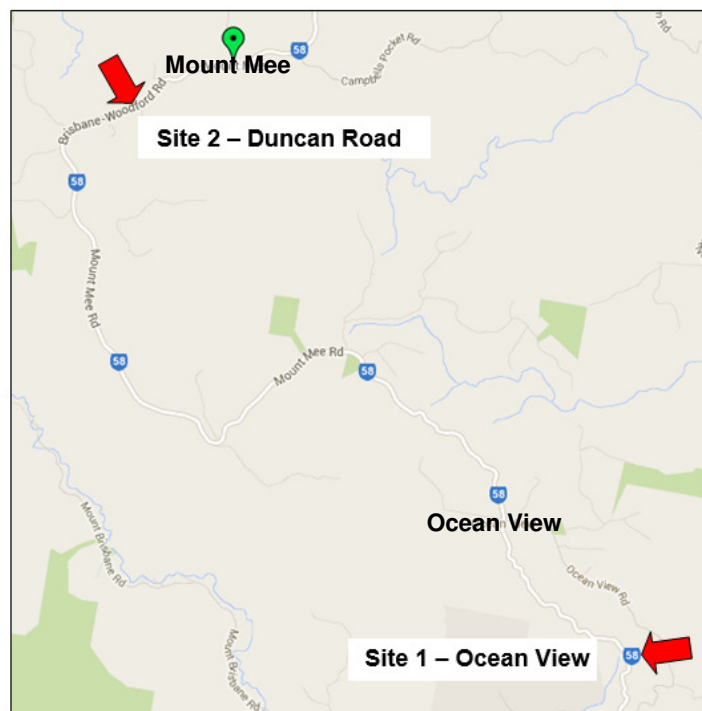
Work will include slope stabilisation and road surface repairs. The project will be completed by the end of September 2014, weather permitting.

We appreciate the inconvenience long-term lane closures have on the community and are endeavouring to get this work done as quickly as possible.

### Traffic arrangements

- Traffic control will be in place 24-hours-a-day while reconstruction work is underway.
- One lane will be closed at both work sites.
- Variable Message Signs will be installed in both directions to advise motorists of changes to traffic conditions and any restrictions.
- Delays can be expected.
- The community will continue to be informed of project progress.
