

Mount Cotton Road – Wuduru Road intersection

The project:

- The Mount Cotton Road and Wuduru Road intersection has a high crash history, particularly right-turn rear-end crashes.
- This project will:
 - o update the road linemarking to include a dedicated southbound right-turn lane from Mount Cotton Road to Wuduru Road
 - o widen the road shoulders
 - o install new road signage and reflective road pavement markers (known as cat's eyes)
- The \$759K works are federally-funded under the Black Spot Program, which targets treatments to improve safety at high-risk locations or 'black spots'.

Expected impacts:

- RoadTek will be constructing the works, which are expected to take 8-10 weeks and start in early-April.
- Work is scheduled Monday to Friday between 6.30am and 5.30pm and Saturdays (if required) from 6.30am until 3pm.
- Mount Cotton Road will be reduced to one lane under stop/go traffic control between 9am and 3.30pm on all work days.
